

**RESORT VILLAGE OF TOBIN LAKE
BYLAW NO. 1/2014**

**A BYLAW OF THE RESORT VILLAGE OF TOBIN LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF
SASKATCHEWAN TO PERMIT THE OPERATION OF A GOLF CART ON
DESIGNATED ROADWAYS AND TRAILS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE RESORT
VILLAGE OF TOBIN LAKE**


The Council of the Resort Village of Tobin Lake, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The Resort Village of Tobin Lake (hereinafter called 'the Resort'), permits the operation of a golf cart during the hours between 6:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. on all designated roadways and trails within the limits of the Resort with the exception of provincial highway No. 255.
2. Notwithstanding sub-section (1) it shall be lawful to operate a golf cart for the purpose of accessing the Resort on provincial highway No. 255 by means of the approach at Hilltop Campground to the beach where highway 255 ends, providing the provisions of *The Traffic Safety Act*, C T-18.1, s. 57(2)(d)(vi), c. T-18.1, S.S. 2004, as amended from time to time, are complied with, and when the access is utilized as the shortest and most direct route available.
3. No person shall operate a golf cart within the limits of the Resort without a valid driver's license.
4. Notwithstanding sub-section (3) individuals 12 to 16 years of age may operate a golf cart when accompanied by a licensed driver.
5. The operator and all passengers of an operating golf cart shall wear a helmet.
6. The number of passengers is limited to the number of seats available.
7. Golf carts must be fashioned with a high visibility flag extending at least six feet from ground level.
8. All personal and public liability shall be the responsibility of the owner/operator of the golf cart.
9. The Resort will appoint enforcement officers to enforce this bylaw and the enforcement officers will enforce this bylaw under authority and direction of the Resort. All Resort employees qualify as enforcement officers.


10. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$100.00.
