


**RESORT VILLAGE OF TOBIN LAKE
BYLAW NO. 2/2005**

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH A FEE TO APPEAL ASSESSMENTS

The Council of The Resort Village of Tobin Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:


1. Persons desiring to appeal their assessment to the Board of Revision for The Resort Village of Tobin Lake shall file their appeal in the form prescribed in *The Urban Municipality Act, 1984*.
2. A fee in the amount of \$75.00 shall accompany the form, or shall be paid to The Resort Village of Tobin Lake within 30 days of the notice of assessment being published in the Saskatchewan Gazette pursuant to subsection 249(4) of *The Urban Municipality Act, 1984*.
3. Where the appellant is successful in whole or in part on an assessment or classification appeal at either the board of revision or the appeal board, The Resort Village of Tobin Lake shall refund any fee that was submitted by the appellant to The Resort Village of Tobin Lake.
4. Where an appellant fails to pay the fee pursuant to Section 2 of this bylaw, the appeal is deemed to be dismissed.
