



**RESORT VILLAGE OF TOBIN LAKE
BYLAW NO. 6/2005**

**A BYLAW OF THE RESORT VILLAGE OF TOBIN LAKE IN THE
PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO PROVIDE FOR BYLAW
ENFORCEMENT**

The Council of the Resort Village of Tobin Lake, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Council may appoint a person(s) as Bylaw Enforcement Officer(s) for the Municipality.
2. The appointment shall be per contract drawn, and the appointment of the Bylaw Enforcement Officer(s) will become effective as contained in the contract.
3. The remuneration of the Bylaw Enforcement Officer(s) shall be set out in the contract.
4. The appointment may be terminated by Council or by the Bylaw Enforcement person giving one month's written notice.
5. The duties of a Bylaw Enforcement Officer shall include:
 - a. To ensure proper application and full compliance of municipal bylaws.
 - b. To represent the municipality before a justice of the peace or a provincial court judge in the prosecution of anyone who is charged with a contravention of a bylaw.
6. That Council accept and acknowledge that the Royal Canadian Mounted Police may enforce any or all bylaws, as they deem necessary.
7. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon the final passing thereof.
8. Bylaw No. 2/2002 passed on the 15th day of April 2002 is hereby repealed.
