A BYLAW DECREERING QUIET TIME IN THE VILLAGE OF TOBIN LAKE.

THE COUNCIL OF THE RESORT VILLAGE OF TOBIN LAKE IN THE  
PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

That the hours from 12:00 midnight to 7:00 A.M. are  
hereby decreed as 'Quiet Time' in the Village of Tobin  
Lake, prohibiting any noises that would disturb the  
peace of others.

Any person found guilty of an infraction of this bylaw  
shall be subject to the penalties provided in the general  
penalty bylaw of the village.
